2. Every device connected to the Internet / Network must have a purchased IP address from PNI, regardless of whether the IP is actually used or not.
3. Priority Networks reserves the right to disconnect any equipment that is found to be causing overall network problems.
4. Client agrees not to resell, extend, bridge, or otherwise misuse Priority Networks' connections and/or services. Priority Networks reserves the right to disconnect client if they are found to have violated this usage agreement.
5. Priority Networks is not responsible for cable and/or equipment provided by the client or a third party.
6. Choice of Law: This agreement shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, the laws of the State of Idaho. In event of litigation, the place of venue shall be in the county of Ada in the State of Idaho.
