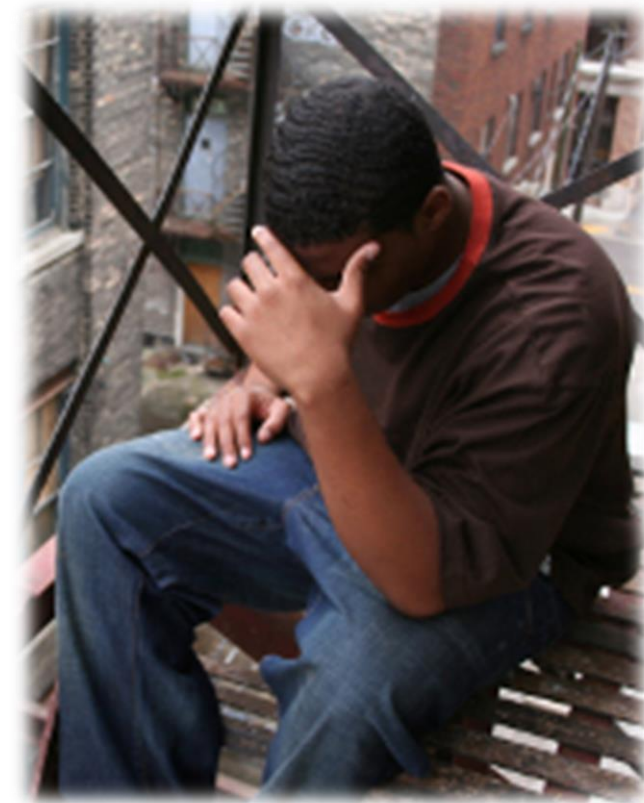

Asia

- Population ~4 billion in 2014
- 1 billion internet users @ June 2012 - 44% of world
- Mobile is critical: ~50% of world's mobile subscribers ~2014
- 3.3 billion people using mobile devices ~2014
- Early adoption of 3G+, now 4G/LTE rolling out
- Yes, India and China are massive markets, but...local players dominate, the barriers to entry are high, barriers to success are higher

- 500+ million population
- 10+ religions
- 300+ ethnic groups

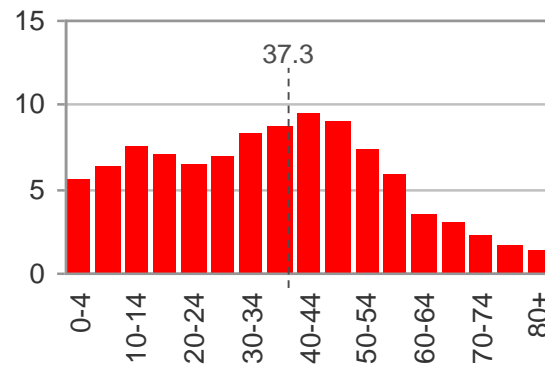

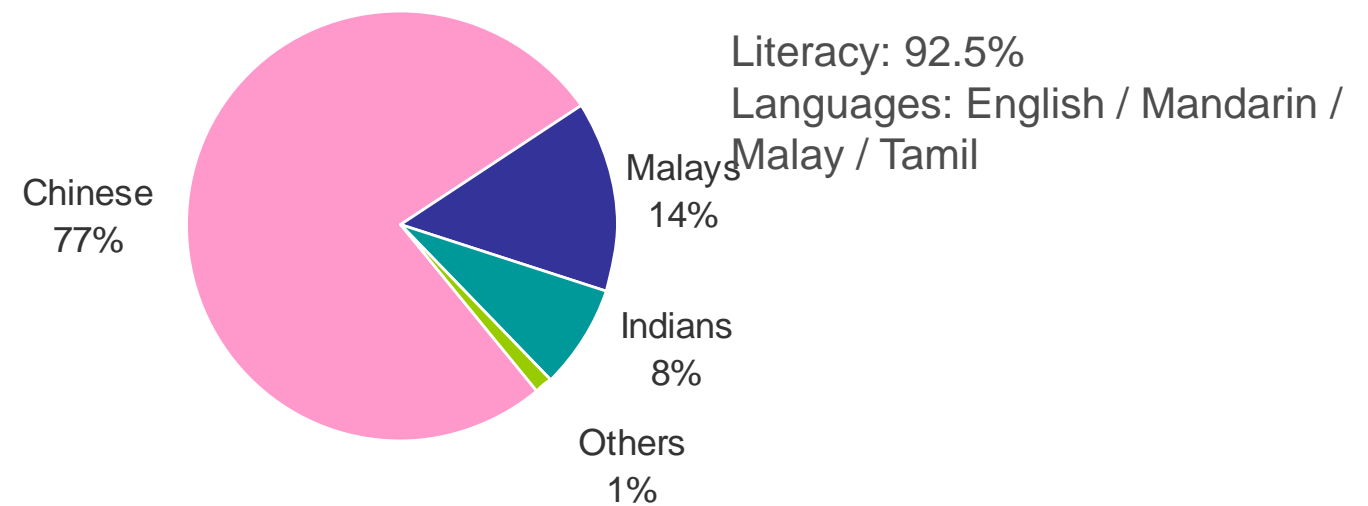

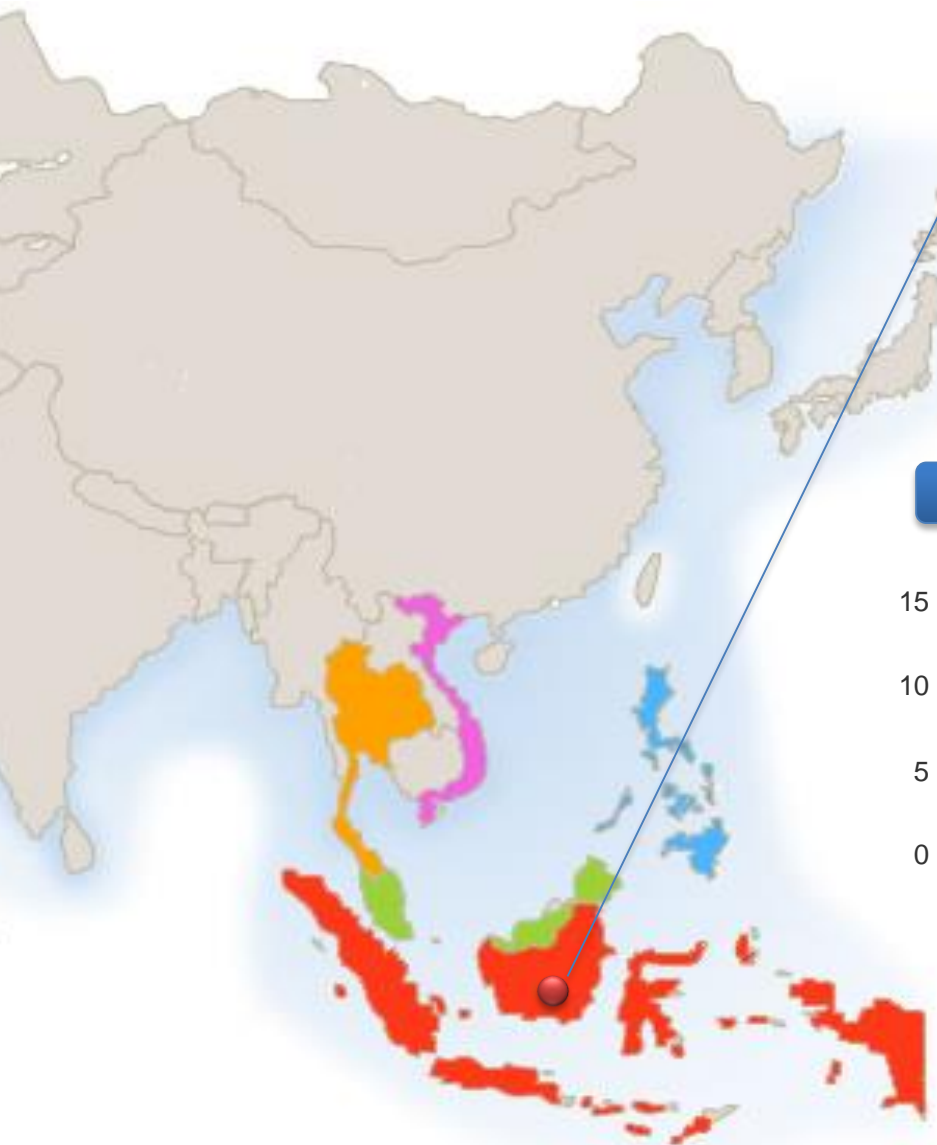
Age Structure



Ethnic Composition



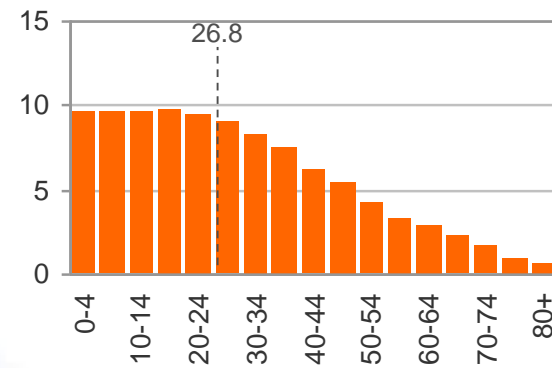
Indonesia

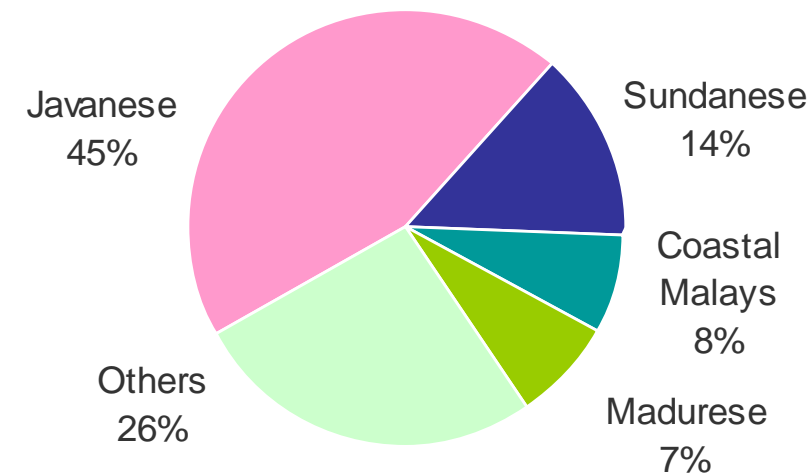
Mobile Connections: 56.3m
