Dr. Elizabeth Feser was on hand to accept the donation on behalf of the school district. The AED units will be assigned to three school buildings in the upcoming school year. Milford Kiwanis chapter president Bill Richards, along with Club members David Kuehn and Mike Boyle, made the formal presentation.
