



Your Summer Camp Questions Answered

Is Summer Camp still happening?

Yes! Although it will look different, The Boys & Girls Club of Milford will still be holding Summer Camp this year. Summer camp will now be 8 weeks from June 22nd 2020, until August 14th 2020.

If I already signed up for Summer Camp is my spot still secured?

Unfortunately, even if you have already signed up previously for Summer Camp we are requiring all families to re-register their child due to the many changes that have been made. Therefore, you will have to re-register for Summer Camp for the weeks and times that you need. If you have already submitted paperwork, please verify via email with Christina at programs@boysandgirlsclubofmilford.com to ensure your paperwork is all set. PLEASE NOTE there is additional paperwork and waivers we need completed in our new registration process. Your spot will not be secured until all of this is completed.

What if I have already paid for Summer Camp prior to the CoronaVirus Pandemic?

Summer camp costs have changed and we are now offering several options for your family. If you would still like to send your child, your prior payment will go towards the new cost of Summer Camp. You would then be responsible for paying the difference within 24 hours of receiving the confirmation of registration email. To decrease contact, all payments will now be debit, credit or check. Checks must be dropped off in the black mailbox located next to our staff entrance in the parking lot.

What do I do if I can not afford the extra cost of Summer Camp?

If you are not able to afford the cost of Summer Camp, we are still offering scholarships for those with extenuating circumstances. We want to be able to service our members that need us most during this time, but scholarships are limited and first come first serve. What happens if I signed up for Summer Camp, but no longer feel comfortable sending my child?

Due to COVID-19 we have made many changes to ensure the utmost safety of our members during this time in order to keep everyone happy and healthy. Although, if you still do not feel comfortable sending your child to camp you are able to get a refund. The refund form can be found on our website under Documents. Please note refunds are only available to families that registered prior to May 28, 2020

What if I had not signed up for Summer Camp? Can I still sign up?

Yes, but registration is as always on a first come first serve basis. BGCM understands the importance of Childcare and the part it plays in allowing parents to work. Thanks to the Board of Education and the City of Milford we have secured additional space if we were to meet our capacity limits. We have a new Summer Camp registration on our website with the updated times, dates, and prices that will go live at 6:00pm on Friday, May 29,2020.

Do I need an updated physical for my child to attend Summer Camp?

No. According to the new OEC regulations for Summer Camp physicals will be valid for 3 years. Therefore, if you have your child's most recent physical from up to 3 years ago it will be accepted.

What precautions are in place to keep my child safe at Summer Camp?

We have been following all updates from the CDC, OEC, and DPH for the most up to date regulations and procedures to be sure we can keep our members as safe as possible. Some of these guidelines include screening all members and staff prior to entering the building, consistent hand washing, sanitizing all rooms/objects between uses, decreased group sizes, separation of groups to limit contact, as well as many more that can be found in our new parent handbook.

Will the staff be wearing PPE/masks during Summer Camp? Will my child have to wear a mask at Summer Camp?

Our staff will be wearing face masks to abide by the OEC regulations as well as our own policies. We want to be sure all of our members as well as staff are safe during this time. Your child will not be required to wear a face mask, but it is strongly recommended.

Will my child still have fun at Summer Camp?

Yes! One of our priorities, after creating the safest environment possible, is to provide our members with a fun and enriching experience! Our staff have been working continuously on creative ways for our members to stay engaged.

Will there still be Field Trips during Summer Camp?

As of right now we are unfortunately not planning any field trips away from the Club, but we do have some fun ideas on how we can bring the field trips to the Club.
